








OXF Recovery Post-Pandemic:

- This August was our busiest for 15 years with highest monthly movements (7,180)
- With the devastation to the UK airline sector, we found ourselves being the second busiest airport in the UK in March 2021
- On the business aviation front, we are 30% busier than same period pre-pandemic (2019)
- Professional Pilot Training Traffic up 38% on 2019 (pre-CV-19) levels
- We exceeded 2020's total movements by mid-September 2021
- Busiest day YTD was May 26th @ 415 movements



OXF International Flights Year to Date

- London Oxford Airport saw flights to or from over 270 different overseas destinations so far this year
- However, with CV-19-related restrictions very little transatlantic traffic and very little Middle-Eastern either
- We have seen several larger aircraft charters for CV-19 'Bubbling' requirements – i.e. EMB-190 for Moto GP (Italy) and EMB-195 for F1 Grind Prix (all Europe) – 100 passengers+


